



I started playing basketball when I was in grade five; learning the fundamental skills and game concepts and as I continued to play throughout my high school years at Britannia, my love and passion for basketball blossomed. In 2010, as a grade nine starting point guard on the Britannia Bruins Junior Girls Tier 1 team, I led the girls to victory in a tough battle against the Kitsilano Blue Demons when we claimed the throne as champions in the VSSAA (Vancouver Secondary School Athletic Association) league. In 2011, I moved up to play at the Senior Girls Tier 1 level and contributed valuable minutes off the bench and became a city champion for another year, once again dethroning the Blue Demons. Following that win, we fought and snatched the title of AA Lower Mainland Champions from the York House Tigers on our home court. We came face to face with the Tigers one more time at the BC AA Provincial Championships final, losing to them in a heart-felt battle in Kamloops but having accomplished so many victories along the way. In 2012, we repeated as city champions after going undefeated in the regular season as well as AA Lower Mainland Champions beating North Vancouver's Seycove Seyhawks in the final. In the same year, we were crowned the BC AA Provincial Champions after beating Victoria's Lambrick Park Pride by slim mark of eight points. Britannia's girls' basketball team has never earned such a prestigious title after only appearing in the provincial tournament twice in 15 years prior to 2012. Finally, as a starting senior in 2013, I was the leading three-point scorer for the Bruins throughout that year. Once again, after going undefeated in the regular season, we three-peated as city champions; defeating the Blue Demons one more time by a crucial 10-point margin in the final.

Because of my love for basketball, I now coach several programs around my neighbourhood, spreading my passion for the game to the younger generations.
